BGVP has organized the following activities during the year 2020-21

- 1. Strenthening the SRHR movement, especially for access to safe Abortion, by creating a Network of and mentoring local CSOs/NGOs in Bihar: In this programme BGVP has created awareness among community for safe abortion and Family Planning for the betterment and empowerment of the family and Govt. Health officials in Dumara and Runnisaidpur block of Sitamarhi district. 2000 family and more than 40 Govt. officials have been benefitted through this programme. This Programme was organized by the support of BVHA (Project of Ipas Development Foundation)
- 2. Organising Health Camp for Flood victims (Sitamarhi district):-In this programme BGVP has organise 8 Free Health check up and Free medicine distribution camp.In which 1250 patient were benefited in 8 flood affected villages in Runnisaidpur,Dumara and Sursand Block of Sitamarhi district in the catchment area of FICCL.This Programme was organised with support of Bihar Voluntary Health Association.(Project of IFCCL)
- 3. Implementation of Flood and COVID19 Relief and Awareness:-This programme was implemented in the 8 flood affected villages in Runnisaidpur, Dumara and Sursand Block of Sitamarhi district in the catchment area of FICCL.850 community people were benefitted with this Awareness on COVID 19 Appropriate behavier and Awareness on Caner. This Programme was organised with support of Bihar Voluntary Health Association. (Project of IFCCL)
- **4. Natural Resource Management:** In this programme 35 people of Runnisaidpur and Belsand block were awared about Natural Resource Management through Dr. Subodh Kumar sinha Trainer. This Programme was organized by **Local Contribution.**
- **5. Water and sanitation awareness:** In this programme we have organised awareness generation camps 25 women were awared about water and sanitation, Health and

Hygiene in flood affected villages of Pichhala Panchayat of Kisanganj block of Kisanganj District. This Programme was organized by **Local Contribution.**

- 6. Environment Protection Awareness Programme:- This programme was organized in organization premises in sitamarhi in which resource person Mr. Ravindra Kumar (Block Agriculture Adviser) told to participant regarding Environment Protection can be made successful by plantation, by the use of vermin compost, green compost in cultivation, by the use of homemade pesticide, by the use of smokeless chulha etc. 30 Participant were benefitted through this awareness programme.
